- a) After the public enquiry the Drumderg Wind Farm got the go-ahead.

Ian Rimmer conducted a telephone poll which found a small majority in favour of the project so on that basis they have been erected. During the pole it was quite interesting to note that there was a lot of support for a 30mph zone through the village.
